

# HEBREW SCHOOL REGISTRATION FORM

Current Hebrew School Class

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By registering my child at the Perrineville Jewish Center Hebrew School, I agree that my child will participate in all family services, and other activities held by the Hebrew School. Students are required to attend Hebrew School regularly. Excessive absences may affect a student's promotion. A student who is absent is required to complete all missed class work. If my child misses a family service or activity, a note of explanation must be presented to the office (Friday night dances and sports events are not acceptable excuses). A makeup Friday night or Saturday may be given at the discretion of the Rabbi. If a child loses a class book, they must replace it by purchasing another book through the Hebrew school.

**Behavior** - a disciplinary procedure is in place and will be followed. It is the policy of the Hebrew School to expect that all students maintain a satisfactory level of citizenship and behavior. Any child sent home with a notice will not be admitted to class on the following day unless notice is signed by a parent. After a third incident, parent will accompany child to class to control behavior, please refer to discipline guidelines.

**Food** - Due to the limited amount of class time, there will be NO snack time during class. Students are not allowed to bring food or drink to class, nor are they permitted to leave the building at anytime to purchase food.

**Bar-Bat Mitzvah lessons** - All students who are to be Bar/Bat Mitzvahed at the synagogue are to observe the following:

1. All religious services will be held at the Perrineville Jewish Center.
2. All preparation lessons days and times will be given at the discretion of the Rabbi.
3. Attendance at services for further preparation are to be attended and are at the discretion of the Rabbi.
4. If a child cannot attend a lesson or service the Rabbi is to be notified as soon as possible. You may leave a message at 732-446-1675. Makeups for cancellations will be given at the discretion of the Rabbi.

Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in dismissal from the program. Cooperation in these matters brings a more productive and unified environment.
